Sewing pins, sewing needles for hand sewing,

Tape measure

Scissors - Paper and fabric

Technical pencil - helpful but not essential

A3 hardback ring binder

A3 hardback file/sketchbook-portrait or landscape

Notebook- A5

A portable shopping trolley (available from most outdoor/indoor markets)- helps you get around with your equipment.

Digital camera or capability on your phone.

Lots the of the following equipment we have available, but some you will have or want to have your own.

Designers Gouache paint set to include primary red, blue, yellow, white and black as a minimum.

Black ink - permanent and non-permanent

Household bleach (in a small lidded container)

Selection of hard and soft drawing pencils, e.g. 7B - 2H

Range of fine liner pens 0.3 - 1.0mm

Charcoal

Markers- various sizes

Dipping pen and nib

A couple of good quality small paint brushes

Household paintbrushes variety of sizes (cheap ones e.g. from Poundland)

Stanley knife with spare blades

A steel ruler

Masking tape, double sided tape, magic tape

Glue stick

DESIRABLE but not essential

Roller (for mono-printing and painting)

Sponge brushes: a variety of sizes and shapes

PVA glue, Putty rubber

Your favourite other media to use- oil pastels, pencils, acrylics etc.
