Materials Shop

Core materials are free at DMU, this includes pattern cutting paper plus any required workshop materials such as yarn for sampling to aid your knitwear workshop sessions. Please be aware you will have to pay for any additional materials you will need to complete your projects, costs will be incurred throughout the year on an ongoing basis, you will have three projects in year one.
